



Recycling Award Categories:

1. **Recycler of the Year** – an individual or a group making an outstanding contribution to the recycling effort in Wyoming
2. **Recycling Event** – a one-time event in which recycling is a major component
3. **Education Program** – a program used to educate a group (of any age) about recycling or a campaign used for education/promotion of increased recycling
4. **New Recycling Program** - A successfully implemented program that is new to the recycler. The program does not have to be innovative.

Note: The Wyoming Solid Waste and Recycling association reserves the right to choose the final category for any entry.

Any Wyoming recycling activity is eligible.
Neither the nominee nor the nominator has to a member of WSWRA.

Entry deadline is July 15, 2008. Award winners will be notified 15 days prior to conference. All winners are asked to prepare a 15 minute informal presentation about their program and present it at the WSWRA Recycling Task Force meeting at the conference. To encourage waste diversion efforts WSWRA offers financial assistance for attendance at the 2008 WSWRA conference in Casper to any category winner, individual or one representative, needing such assistance (conference fee waived plus lodging.)
